

The Perth Mint Privacy Policy has been updated with the following changes:

- Consolidated our Privacy Policy and Privacy Notice for United States Residents to form one comprehensive Privacy Policy ("The Perth Mint Privacy Policy"). The Privacy Notice for United States Residents is now obsolete.
- Changed the term used to refer to your data. We will now use "Personal Data" instead of Personal Information or Personally Identifiable Information.
- Consolidated the Introduction and Scope subsections and used them to create two new subsections, What is covered by this Policy and What is not covered by this Policy to further clarify what data the Privacy Policy applies to.
- Consolidated all references related to categories, collection and disclosure of Personal Data
  and used them to create a new subsection, What Personal Data we process, How we obtain
  it and Third parties that we share data with. We have also clarified the categories and types
  of Personal Data we collect so the list is more comprehensive and have provided additional
  information about how we protect your Personal Data when we share it overseas.
- Consolidated all references related to the use of Personal Data and used them to create two
  new subsections, For what purposes do we use your Personal Data and Lawful bases for
  processing. We have also included further information about the legal bases we use to
  process your data.
- Consolidated all references related to the retention of Personal Data and used them to create a new subsection, **How long we keep your Personal Data.** We have also included further information about the reasons we are required to retain your data.
- Simplified the subsection on **Use of cookies, websites and applications**. For more information about use of cookies, please see our cookie notice.
- Consolidated all references related to our mailing list and used them to create a new subsection, Use of mailing list.
- Consolidated all references related to your rights and used them to create new subsections,
   What privacy rights do you have, Your rights under the Privacy Act, Your rights under the
   General Data Protection Regulation and Your rights under the California Consumer Privacy
   Act. We have also included further information regarding your rights under the GDPR.
- Updated the contact details for our Data Protection Officer so individuals in Europe, the European Economic Area and the United Kingdom can easily access them.
- Reworded several statements to ensure compliance with relevant privacy and data protection laws that specify such policies and/or notices must be written in simple and clear language.
