Details of the Competition			
Competition:	Hide and Ssseek Australian Lunar Series III 2025 Competition

Competition Period:	The Competition starts on the 11 January 2025 at 9:00 AM AWST and ends on the 17 February 2025 at 5:00 AM AWST		
Eligibility:	<p>This Competition is open to anyone who is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an Australian resident, including children under the age of 18 years. <p>Please note, while this Competition is open to everyone, it is designed as an activity for children under the age of 18 years.</p> <p>Entrants under the age of 18 years must obtain the consent of their parent or legal guardian to be eligible to participate in the Competition. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for their child’s entry.</p>

For entries at the Perth Zoo: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. collect a “Hide & Ssseek” activity map and competition sheet at the Zoo’s front gates; b. use the activity map as a guide to find all five lunar snakes hidden at different locations (which will also be identifiable by floor decals) around the Zoo. Each snake holds a single letter in their tail which participants must use to solve a five-letter password; and c. once you have solved the password, submit the completed competition sheet into the designated returns box located at the lockers to gain one valid entry. 2. For entries at The Perth Mint (310 Hay Street): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. collect a “Hide & Ssseek” competition sheet at The Perth Mint’s Reception Desk (Reception) after booking a Perth Mint Gold Tour; b. find all five lunar snakes hidden at different locations around The Perth Mint’s front forecourt gardens. Each snake holds a single letter which participants must use to solve a five-letter password; and c. once you have solved the password, submit the completed competition sheet into the designated returns box located inside the Reception (in front of the fireplace) to gain one valid entry.
