

## The Perth Mint Luxury Jewellery and Launch of Jewellery Event Competition Terms and Conditions

Details of the Competition			
<b>Competition</b>	The Perth Mint Luxury Jewellery and Launch of Wedding Jewellery Event Competition		
<b>Promoter</b>	Gold Corporation trading as The Perth Mint (ABN 98 838 298 431) whose registered address is 310 Hay Street, East Perth, WA 6004 Australia		
<b>Competition Period</b>	The Competition <b>starts at 6:30pm AWST</b> and <b>ends at 8:10pm AWST</b> on <b>Thursday, 10 October 2024</b>		
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>To be eligible, a participant must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an Australian resident; and</li> <li>• at least 16 years of age, provided that entrants who are below the age of 18 must seek prior consent of their parent or legal guardian to be considered eligible.</li> </ul>		
<b>Territory</b>	Australia		
<b>Participation method</b>	<p>To participate in this Competition, an eligible participant must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• attend the 'The Perth Mint Luxury Jewellery and Launch of Wedding Jewellery Event' (<b>Event</b>) at the Perth Mint premises on 10 October 2024;</li> <li>• post a photo or video of the Event to <b>Instagram</b> using the hashtag #PerthMintWeddingCollection and <b>tagging @theperthmintaustralia</b> during the Competition Period;</li> <li>• ensure their Instagram account privacy setting is configured to 'public' to ensure the entries can be viewed and evaluated by the Promoter.
